

WHAT SHOULD WE DO SPIRITUALLY (Concerning the Coronavirus)? (Robbi's message 3/15/2020)

1. Pray DAILY (English and tongues)

- a. 2 Chronicles 7:14 ... If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
- b. Philippians 4:6 ... Do not be anxious or worried about anything, but in everything [every circumstance and situation] by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, continue to make your requests known to God.
- c. James 1:5 ... Do any of you need wisdom? Ask God for it. He is generous and enjoys giving to everyone. So he will give you wisdom.
- d. Jude 1:20 ... Build yourselves up in your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit.
- e. Matthew 6:9-13, Matthew 18:19-20, Mark 11:22-24, 1 John 5:14

2. Plead the Blood of Jesus over yourself, your family, and your church DAILY

- a. Revelation 12:11 ... Our people defeated Satan because of the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony.

3. Declare the protection of Psalms 91 over yourself, your family, and your church DAILY

- a. Psalms 91:1-16 ... Because I live in the shelter of the Most High, I find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. This I declare of You Lord, "You alone are my refuge, my place of safety. You are my God, and I trust You." You rescue me from every trap and protect me from the fatal plague (epidemic, viruses). You shield me with Your wings. You shelter me with Your feathers. Your faithful promises are my armor and protection. I am not afraid of the terrors of the night; I do not fear the dangers of the day. I do not dread the plague that stalks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday. Though a thousand fall at my side, though ten thousand are dying around me, these evils will not touch me. But I will see it with my eyes; I will see how the wicked are punished. Because I have made You Lord my refuge, and the Most High my shelter, no evil will conquer me. No plague will come near my dwelling.

For God, You order Your angels to protect me wherever I go. They will hold me with their hands to keep me from striking my foot on a stone. I trample down lions and poisonous snakes. I crush fierce lions and serpents under my feet! Lord, You rescue me because I love You. You protect me because I trust in Your name. When I call on You, You answer. You are with me in trouble. You rescue me and honor me. You satisfy me with a long life, and You give me Your salvation (deliverance, healing, health, wholeness, help, prosperity, victory, preservation, safety, rescue from danger).

4. Keep fear out

- a. John 14:27 TPT ... *Jesus speaking* ... "I leave the gift of peace with you—my peace. Not the kind of fragile peace given by the world, but my perfect peace. Don't yield to fear or be troubled in your hearts—instead, be courageous!
- b. Isaiah 26:3 NLT ... [God] You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

5. Trust God to be faithful to His Word

- a. 1 James 5:14-15 ... This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.
- b. Isaiah 55:11 ... In the same way, the promise that I make does not return to me, having accomplished nothing. No, it is realized as I desire and is fulfilled as I intend.

WHAT SHOULD WE DO NATURALLY (Concerning the Coronavirus)?

1. Wash your hands often

- a. The Centers for Disease says we need to wash our hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after we've been in a public place, or after blowing our nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- b. If no soap is available, an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol may be used.

2. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth

- a. Especially if we haven't washed our hands. Make this a habit.

3. Cover coughs and sneezes

- a. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- b. Throw used tissues in the trash.
- c. Immediately wash your hands with soap and water after sneezing and coughing

4. Clean and disinfect

- a. Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.

5. And Centers for Disease also says...

- a. Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- b. If you are sick, stay home.
- c. Replace handshakes with elbow bumps.
- d. Stay at least 6 feet away from others when in a public setting.
